Requirements

- Currently licensed to practice by the Nevada State Board of Nursing. Must have a valid driver's license.
- CPR certification and successful completion of Handle with Care training including appropriate use of Seclusion and Restraint, within 30 days of employment, and prior to assisting in a restraining process. Must pass a medication administration exam.
