This year's annual meeting of the Nevada Nurses Association (NNA) will be conducted utilizing the same video conference format that was so successful for our 2008 annual meeting. A simultaneous video broadcast between Carson City and Las Vegas is planned for October 24, 2009 between 9 a.m. and 12 p.m. The use of high-technological video conferencing, will afford NNA members from both Northern and Southern Nevada an economical way to attend and participate in the meeting. The conference site in Carson City is Western Nevada College, located at 2201 W. College Parkway (the Reynolds Building, Room 101). In Las Vegas, the meeting site is in Suite 150 of the Area Health Education Center (AHEC) at 3014 West Charleston Boulevard.

The meeting's agenda will include an address by the NNA president, Tracy L. Singh, JD, RN and followed by a continuing education (CE) program.
